

Introducing new phonic sound 'nt'.

1. Write the letters on whiteboard and make the sound. Ask children to repeat several times.
2. Give children a word ending in 'nt', e.g. bent. Ask children for other rhyming words.
3. Now make a sample sentence with an 'nt' word. Ask children to give other ones.
4. Draw pictures on whiteboard to represent 'nt' words.
5. Ask children for initial sounds of the 'nt' words.
6. Try now to vary the central vowel in the 'nt' words. *bent ant don't*
7. Find words with 'nt' in them.
8. Write down the words on the whiteboard and draw the pictures. Children to do this in their books.
9. Close books and try to write new words in another book as teacher says them. Tell children how many letters they should have.
10. Introduce one or two new ones to reinforce previously learnt sounds.
11. Orally correct words. Reinforce words used by orally saying sentence together with teacher.
